The next Mobile World Congress (26th February – February 29th 2024) is the mobile technology premier event worldwide. MWCapital Barcelona is an initiative aimed at turning the city into the permanent global center of mobile technologies, where people, companies and institutions work together to exploit the potential of mobile technologies as an element to transform daily life and create new business opportunities.

At the most recent MWC held in February/March 2023, about **88,500 participants from 202 different countries** converged to experience a multitude of product showcases and announcements, and sources of inspiration and innovation. **Over 2,400 companies** showcased their organizations through exhibition booths and hospitality areas spread across eight halls and outdoor venues at Fira Gran Via. It is estimated that 2024 will have increased figures compared to 2023.<u>4YFN</u> (for young Startups) is a side exhibition in one Hall of MWC. MWC is focussing on SMEs and Scaleup Startups.



MWC2024 organized by GSMA will innovate the next year congress with following <u>themes</u>:

Connecting everything: By 2030, there will be 6.3 billion unique mobile subscribers and five billion global 5G connections. To accommodate the growing number of connected IoT devices, a collaborative effort involving various network stakeholders is essential to develop adaptable, automated, and cost-efficient networks for businesses and consumers.

5G and beyond: The evolution of 5G and the emergence of 6G are driving intelligence at the network edge, enabling fast learning, self-orchestration, and innovative interaction possibilities with devices.

However, as mobile generations roll out more quickly, the longer-term return on investment challenges patience in an industry that's rapidly advancing with new features and opportunities.

Humanising AI: Generative AI's impact is significant, with applications ranging from optimizing network and cloud processes to enhancing natural interactions and personalized customer experiences. The evolving landscape, centered on data and data management, promises disruptive yet exciting changes, with much more innovation to come.

Manufacturing DX: Manufacturers are heavily investing in digital strategies, and 5G holds promise for the manufacturing sector, where private wireless networks and data-driven solutions can significantly enhance efficiency and reduce costs in smart factories and warehouses. The broader adoption of technologies like AI and robotics, supported by initiatives from organizations like the European Commission, is paving the way for realizing the full potential of Industry 4.0.


Game changers:


