

Pop: 9 million


Density: 207/km<sup>2</sup>

- 80 km of track
- Longest fully-automated driverless system in the world
- Driven by linear induction motors




# **Calgary/Edmonton Expansions**

- Valley Line West: 2026






### **Greater Toronto Area, Ontario (6.7 mil)**


